### Personal coverage application for nonsubject corporate officers

Each nonsubject corporate officer (officer) listed below requests coverage as a subject worker and entitlement to benefits provided by the Oregon Workers' Compensation Law.

Therefore, the corporation agrees to pay premiums to SAIF based on actual officer payroll within the minimum and maximum limits established by the National Council on Compensation Insurance at the premium rate for the type of work performed by each officer. The corporation and its officers understand this reported payroll is the basis for benefits paid on any compensable injury.

Payroll for these officers must be reported and premiums paid until a cancellation request signed by a corporate officer is received by SAIF.

**NOTE: This application applies only to corporate officers who are directors and have substantial ownership interest in the corporation. To have "substantial ownership interest," officers must meet at least one of these two criteria: (1) have at least 10 percent of the ownership; or (2) have an ownership percentage equal to or greater than the average ownership of all stockholders. Corporations in the landscaping, construction, or timber harvesting industries should use the Designation of Construction/Timber/Landscaping Corporate Officer Exemption form 3267.**
