Should I wear gloves?

Box cutter blades are razor-sharp. Wear gloves if you can.

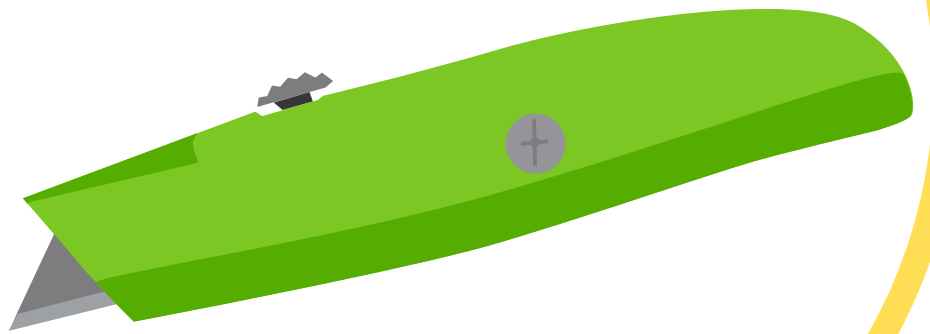

Is my blade sharp?

Yes—and keep it that way. Dull blades tug and snag, increasing the chance of slipping. Also, expose only enough blade to do the job.

Select a box cutter with safety features, such as guards.

Which direction should I cut?

Cut deliberately and at an angle away from your body.

Where does my knife go when I'm done?

When you're not using it, retract the blade and store the knife safely. (Or use a self-retracting blade.)

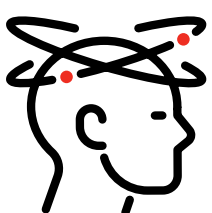

Where do I put dull blades?

Always use a designated disposal box that is puncture resistant.
